NOTES

- 1 The financial results were reveiwed by the Audit Committee and were thereafter approved by the Board of Directors of the Company at their respective meetings held on 12/09/2020. The Statutory Auditors of the company have carried out the limited review in respect of the financial results for the quarter ended 30th June 2020.
- 2 The financial results have been prepared in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standards (IND AS) as notified under the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 as specified in section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013.
- 3 The financial results for the quarter ended 30th June, 2020 are also IND AS compliant. The management has exercised necessary due diligence to ensure that the financial results give a true and fair view. This information has not been subjected to limited review or audit.
- 4 Segment Reporting as defined in IND AS 108 is not Applicable Since Company has only one reportable Segment.
- 5 The figures for the previous quarter/ year have been regrouped/reclassified wherever necessary to make them comparable.
- 6 The weighted average number of equity shares outstanding during the period has been considered for calculation basic and diluted Earning per share (not annualized) in accordance with IND AS-33 "Earning per Share".
- 7 Figures for the quarter ended March 31, 2020 represents the difference between the audited figures in respect to the full financial year and the published figures of nine months ended December 31, 2019, which were subjected to limited review.
- 8 The Company has adopted measures to curb the impact of COVID-19 pandemic in order to protect the health of its employees and ensure business continuity with minimal disruption including remote working, maintaining social distancing, sanitization of workspaces etc. Considering the limitations in operations due to lockdown, the Company's total revenue from operations and profit for the period were impacted due to lower sales volume for the quarter ended June 30, 2020 as compared to Quarter ended March 31, 2020 and June 30, 2019. The Company has considered the impact of this pandemic on its business operations and financial results based on its review of current indicators of future economic conditions and expects that the carrying amount of the assets will be recovered. However, the impact assessment of COVID-19 pandemic is a continuing process given the uncertainties associated with its nature and duration and accordingly the impact may be different from that estimated as at the date of approval of these financial results. The Company will continue to monitor any material changes to future economic conditions.
- 9 Tax expenses includes current tax and deferred tax.
 10 In the Current Period the company have recognized Indirect Duty related expenses of Rs. 8049518/- in Statement of Profit & Loss Account, as per the Gujarat Vera Samadhan Yojana Order under Gujarat VAT Act, 2006.
